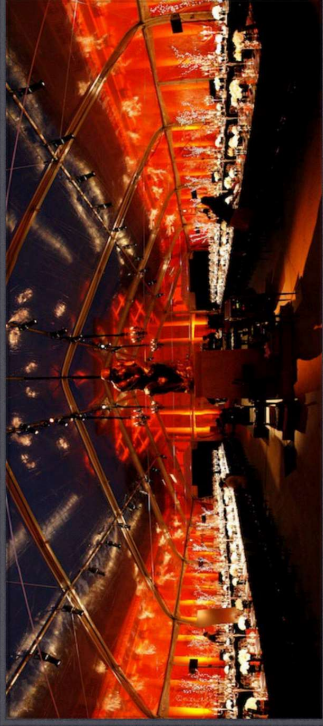


Types of tents

- Structures*
- Tension tents*
- Frame tents*

Structures

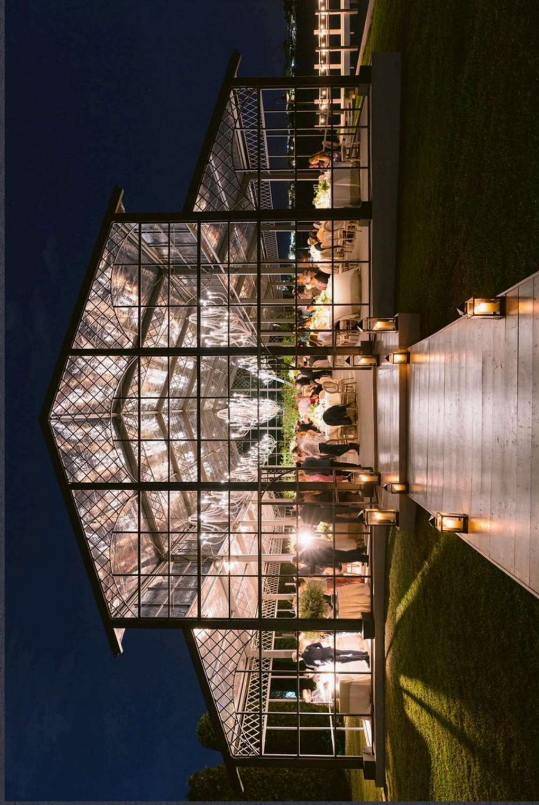
“Clear span” - Kedered beams
Curved beam or A-frame style
50’, 60’, 70’, 80’, 100’ & 120’ widths



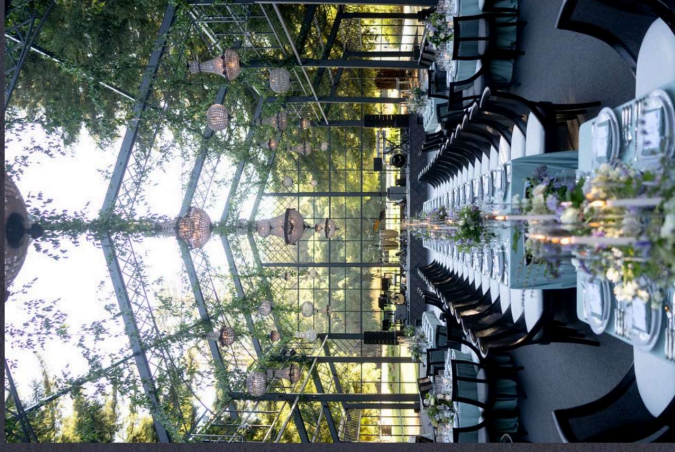

Structures - Atrium

Currently 50' (30' middles & 10' wings)
Rental companies outside CA can purchase

Structures

Pros:

- Heavy rig loads
- Tall gable ends
- No scissor cables
- Multiple ballast types
- No wallpole angle brace (possibly)
- Engineerable

Cons:

- Access for heavy equipment
- Exposed beams without draping
- Cost

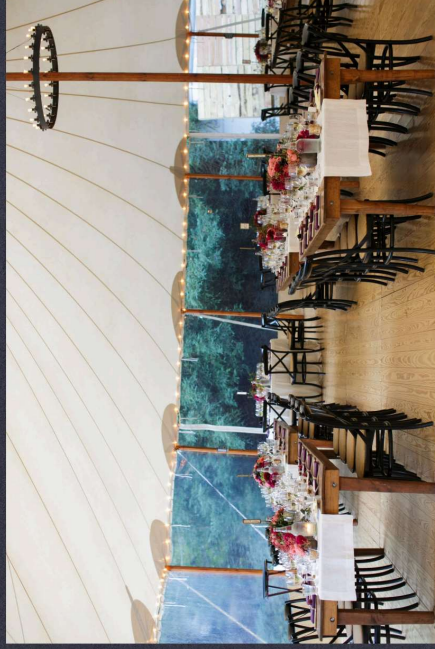

Tension Tents

Fabric tension

Push pole - Bail ring - Sail cloth



Tension Tents

Pros:

- High, regal peaks
- No draping needed
- Can add fabric valences
- Economical

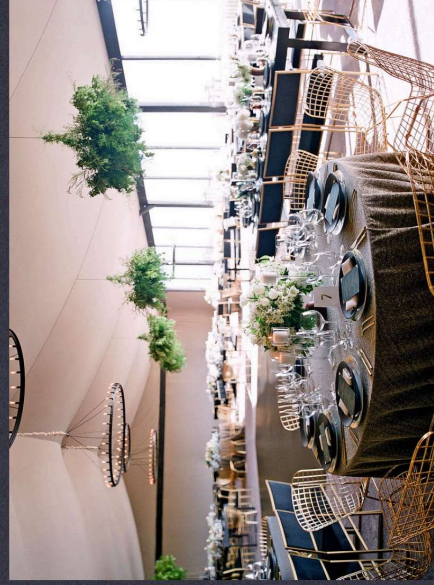
Cons:

- Staking required
- Poles inside tent
- Difficult to engineer



Frame Tents

Pipe supported canopy
2" or Jumbo track framework
Festival style

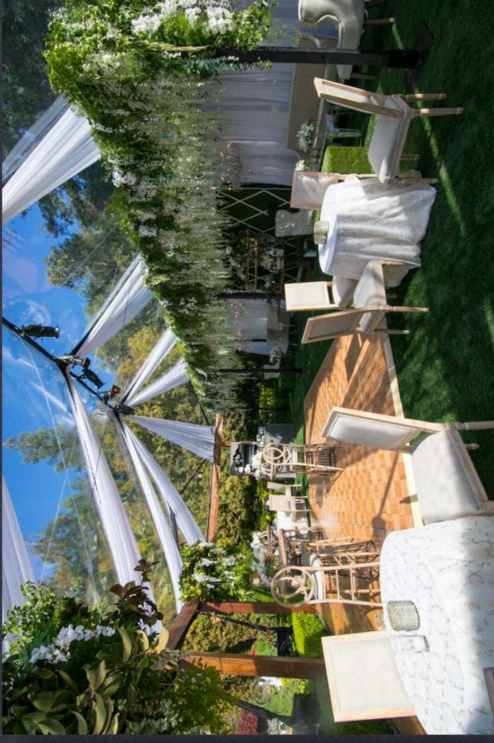

Frame Tents

Pros:

- Perfect for smaller events (6' -50' wide)
- Unlimited expansion
- Hip & Gable ends
- Multiple ballast types
- Economical

Cons:

- Scissor Cables
- Wallpole angle brace
- No heavy fixtures
- Difficult to engineer

Colored tent vinyl skins

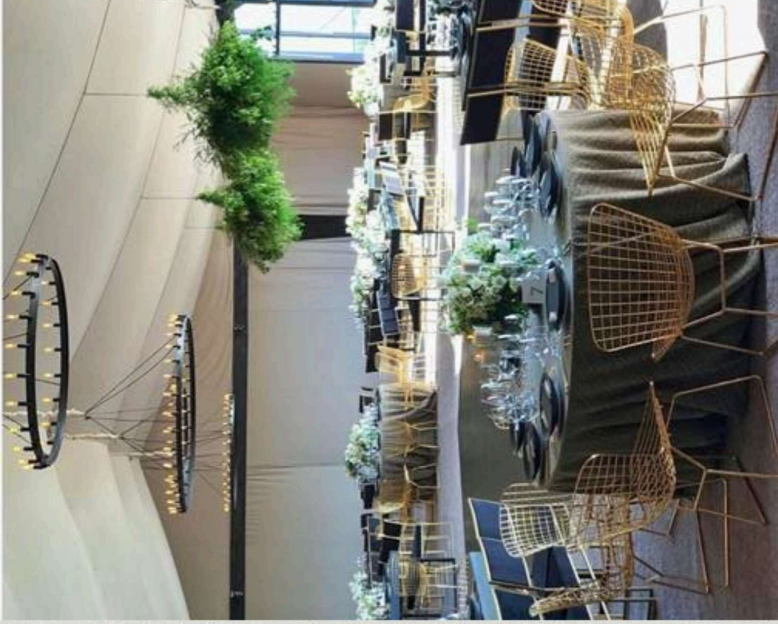
Tents Transformed

(straight off roll so doesn't wrinkle)

& ceiling pitch)

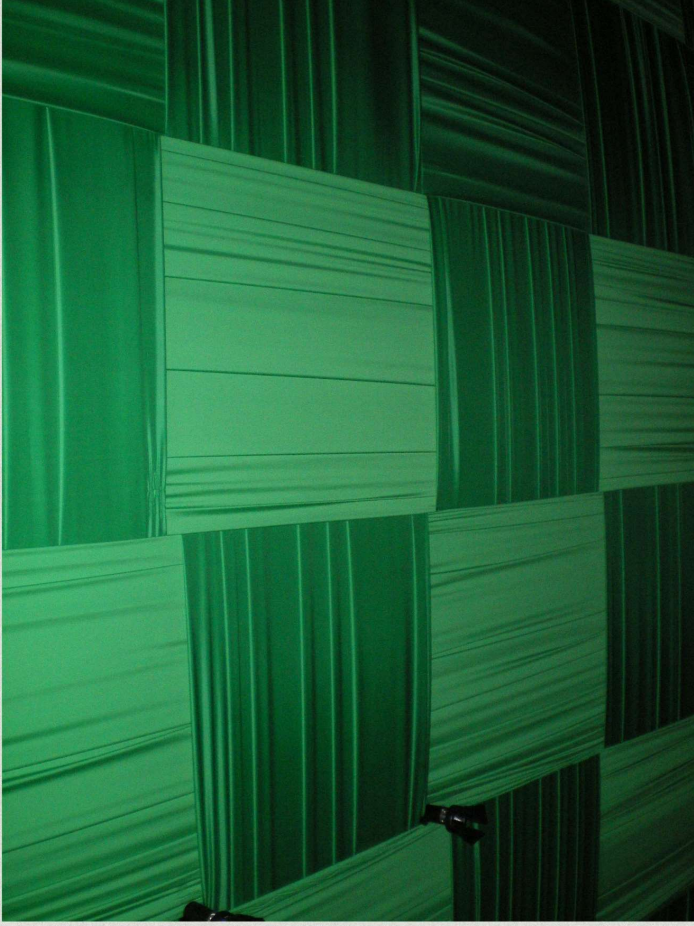

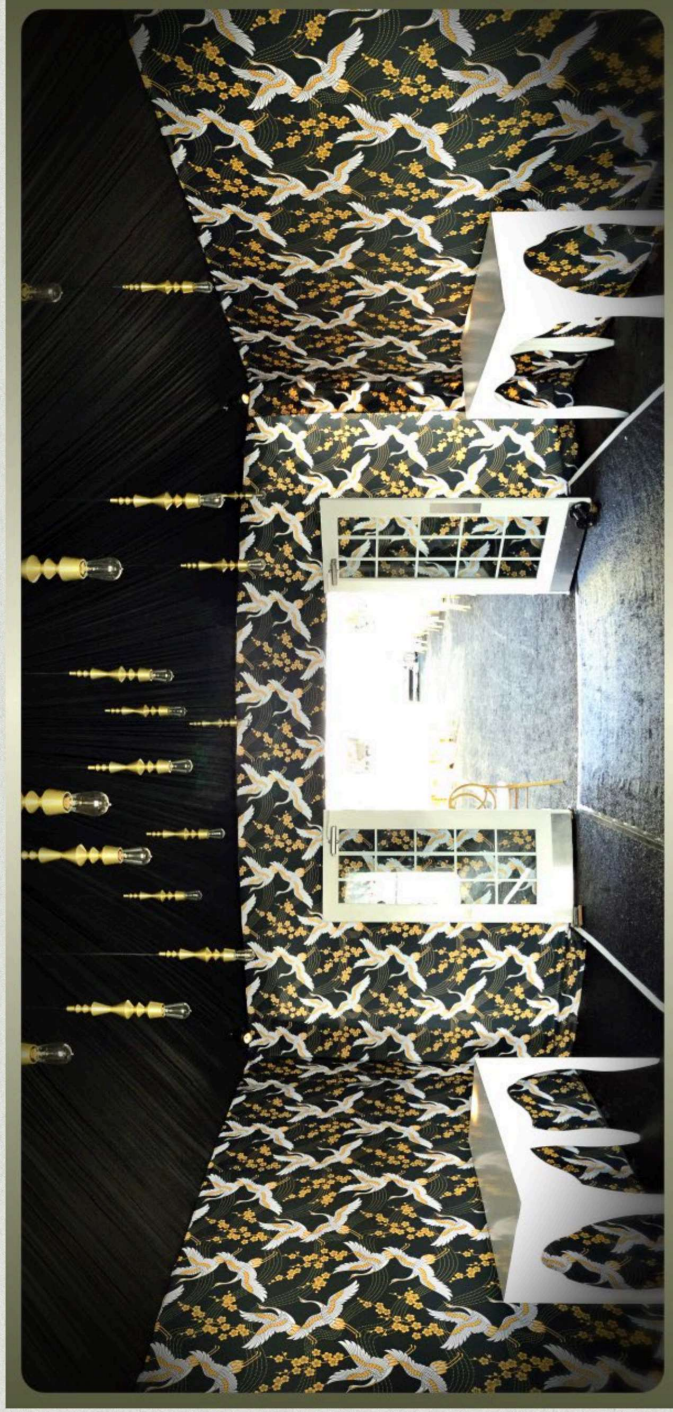

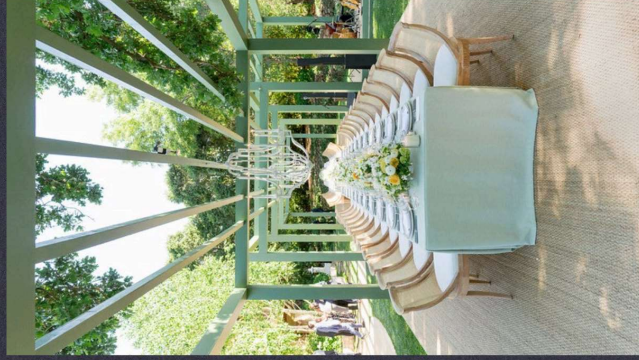
10' & 12' tall uprights – 9 1/4" x 9 1/4" beams

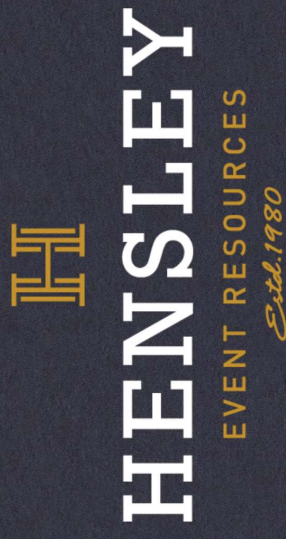
